Morsels N' More... Grasshopper Parfait

Ingredients:

- 1 7.8oz pkg of instant chocolate pudding
- 4 cups milk
- 2 cups Cool Whip
- 1tsp mint extract
- Green food coloring—a few drops
- 15 Oreos crushed (plus a few extra for garnish)
- Chocolate chips or Andes mint chocolates, optional for garnish



Instructions:

- In a medium bowl, whisk together pudding mix and milk. Let stand for 5 minutes.
- While pudding is setting, mix food coloring and mint extract into whipped cream until blended.
- Layer chocolate pudding, whipped cream, crushed cookies into cups and repeat layers.
- Top with whole Oreo and Andes mint, then refrigerate for 30 minutes.
