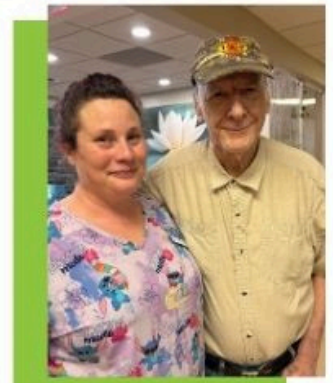

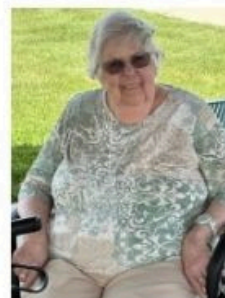
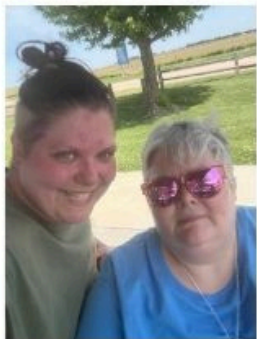

Morsels N' More: Furikake Chex Mix

Ingredients

The Chip Mix

- 1 box Rice Chex
- 1 box Corn Chex
- 1 box Honeycomb cereal
- 1 bag of Bugles
- 1 bag of pretzels

The Syrup Mix

- 1 C butter
- ½ C syrup of choice
- ⅔ C sugar
- ⅔ C vegetable oil
- 2 T soy sauce
- 1 1.7oz bottle Nori Goma Furikake



Instructions

- Preheat oven to 250° F. In two large pans, divide the chip mix, evenly between the two pans. Set aside.
- Melt the butter in a saucepan, then add in the syrup of choice, sugar, vegetable oil, and soy sauce. Stir to mix.
- Pour the syrup over the two pans of chex mix, make sure to divide the syrup equally. Toss the chex mix until all the pieces are evenly coated.
- Pour ½ bottle of Nori Goma Furikake on each pan. Stir until the furikake is mixed evenly.
- Bake at 250F for 1 hour. Take the pan out every 15 minutes to toss/mix to make sure it cooks evenly.
- Remove from oven, let cool. Then divide up into bags/containers and share this is a Hawaiian Holiday Treat!
