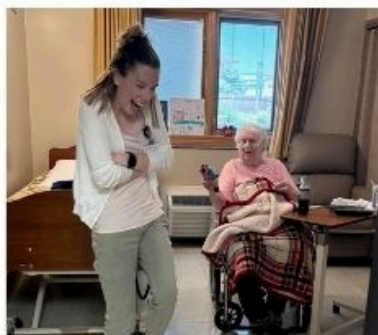

Morsels N' More: Mini Ice Cream Cake Cups

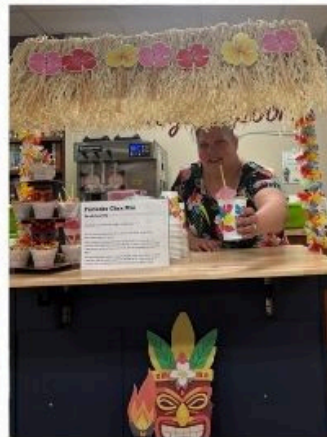
Ingredients

- 10 Oreo's, finely crushed
- 1 tbs melted butter
- 12 tbs chocolate ice cream, softened
- 6 tbs fudge topping
- 18 tbs vanilla ice cream, softened
- red, white, and blue sprinkles
- 6 5-oz portion cups



Instructions

1. In a bowl, mix the crushed Oreo cookies and melted butter with a fork until well combined. Set aside.
2. Place 2 tablespoons of chocolate ice cream into each portion cup and flatten into an even layer.
3. Put the cups in the freezer for 20 minutes to allow the chocolate ice cream to firm up.
4. Remove from the freezer and add a layer of the Oreo mixture. Top with 1 tablespoon of fudge sauce.
5. Spread 3 tablespoons of vanilla ice cream over the fudge layer.
6. Finish with colorful sprinkles.
7. Freeze for at least 1 hour, or until ready to serve.
